# Guidance for families travelling to the UK: New ETA Visa Rules

#### What is an ETA?

The UK has introduced an **Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA)** for visitors from certain countries. This is a new entry requirement that must be obtained **before** travelling to the UK. It is similar to travel authorisations in place in other countries, such as the USA's ESTA or Canada's ETA.

#### Who needs an ETA?

- This list details nationalities that currently need an ETA, and those that will from 2 April 2025. In general, any
  country that previously did not need a visa will now need an ETA.
- It will be gradually expanded to other visa-exempt travellers.
- Children require their own ETA, regardless of age.

#### Who does NOT need an ETA?

- UK and Irish passport holders.
- Travellers with a valid UK visa (eg a Child Student Visa or Leave to Remain).
- · British residency permit holders.

## How to apply

- Applications must be completed <u>online</u> or via mobile app.
- Required information includes a valid passport, recent photo and travel details.
- · A small fee is payable per applicant.

# **Processing time**

• Most ETAs are approved within 72 hours, it is advised to apply well in advance of travel in case of issues.

## How long is the ETA valid?

- Once approved, an ETA is usually valid for two years or until the passport expires (whichever comes first).
- It allows multiple short visits to the UK (typically up to six months per visit).

## Important notes for parents

- Each child must have their own ETA (parents cannot apply for a family group under one application).
- All passports must be valid for the duration of travel.
- Without an ETA, boarding a flight or entering the UK will not be permitted.
- For the latest updates and to check if your country is included, visit the <u>UK Government's official guidance</u> before planning your trip.

### Summary

#### Who needs an ETA?

- European nationals, US nationals, citizens of other countries participating in the programme who are travelling to the UK for tourism, business or transit.
- Anyone without a UK visa or residence permit.

## How to apply?

- Apply online via the official <u>UK government website.</u>
- Processing time: Up to 72 hours (but can be longer if UKVI have queries or concerns).

## Without an ETA you will be unable to enter the UK after 2 April 2025.
